- Nonviolent ways to deal with interpersonal conflicts
- Understanding that peace builders are both reactive and proactive

To expedite this goal the Shrine will utilize its spacious and beautiful grounds, The Trinity House, The Tower of Remembrance, and Shrine Chapel with Turning From Violence Icon as ideal meeting places to present and involve your students in the **Building Bridges To Peace Program**. This program does not have to be only limited to a one day offering. The Shrine encourages follow-up experiences that can be developed jointly by you, your students and Shrine facilitators to meet the needs of your students and school curriculum.
